

## NATIONAL YEARLY PHILANTHROPY PROJECT

Chapters are encouraged to submit a Philanthropy project each year to be endorsed or refused by the National Philanthropy Committee.

### Submission Requirements:

1. National non-profit organization
2. Organization's current supporters
3. Detailed description of:
  - a. Age groups assisted
  - b. Type of assistance
  - c. Length of assistance
4. Organization contact information
5. Year submission date December 10th

A chapter may submit more than one project as long as all the guidelines are met.

When the Philanthropy Committee meets at Midyear with the National President and Secretary of Philanthropy, each project will be presented and discussed. The Committee, following the Bylaws of the Golden Hand Fund, Article XV, Section 2, will endorse or refuse to endorse a project. The Committee will send notice and details of endorsed proposals for consideration to the chapters and voting members at least sixty days prior to national convention. A majority vote at national convention shall be required for the final approval of that year's project.
